To help your child meet the district and school goals, the school, you, and your child will work together:

SCHOOL/TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Amy Northwest will:

-Hold parent-teacher conferences three times each year during which the individual child's achievement will be discussed with parents. Offer in a zoom / virtual format if needed and appropriate.
-Host a Parent Training on Technology at home at least once during the school year, including access to Parent Portal. Parents will be provided ongoing reports of student progress during the school year.
-Host a Literacy and or Math Night for parents to learn more about how to support these subjects at home including games and family reading.
Parents will be notified of the above times and events via letters and flyers home, parents link messages, and remind me texts. We will also provide parents reasonable access to staff. AMY Northwest has an open door policy. Parents can make appointments to see teachers as needed via email and phone scheduling.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

We, as parents, will:

Monitor student attendance.
Monitor student grades- check grade book weekly
Schedule doctor appointments during off school hours where possible.
Make sure that homework is completed.
Check the students agenda books and portfolios.
Monitor the amount of my child's screen time.
Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.
Promote positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
Stay informed about my child's education and communication with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.
Serving, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups, such as the Schools Advisory Council (SAC).
